Michigan Livestock Expo, sale gels with Ag Expo

With cooperation from Ag Expo, a new livestock show and sale designed to showcase Michigan's livestock agriculture industry has been scheduled for July 17-19 at the Ingham County Fairgrounds in Mason. A sale will follow at the Michigan State University Livestock Pavilion July 21 during Expo.

The show and sale, in conjunction with both Michigan Dairy Expo and Ag Expo, will feature market steers, market lambs, market hogs and market goats. There also will be a dairy component to the event, said Ernie Birchmeier, livestock specialist with Michigan Farm Bureau.

"The event will be highlighted by a sale of award-winning animals and products and a showcase of Michigan agriculture at the MSU Livestock Pavilion on Tuesday evening, July 21," Birchmeier said. "As we work on details, people are excited about the opportunity to showcase livestock agriculture. This will be a youth show, designed to showcase the best of Michigan's animal agriculture industry," he said. "It's an opportunity to enhance the livestock industry just before Michigan State University's Ag Expo and Dairy Expo, and to give young people the chance to participate in what we hope will become the premier multi-species livestock event in the state. It's also a great opportunity for our youth livestock exhibitors and our agri-business community to come together for a great event. We encourage business and industry to support our youth by buying at the auction."

Representatives of Michigan Farm Bureau, GreenStone Farm Credit Services, the Michigan Agri-Business Association, Michigan Milk Producers Association, Michigan United Conservation Clubs, and Michigan State University launched the show and sale. There also has been great support so far from many agri-businesses.

The non-terminal show is also a great opportunity for youth to showcase their animals and get valuable show ring experience heading into the county fair season, Birchmeier said.
